2026 Contributions and Charges

The Charthouse Primary School Board has endorsed the Schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2026.

To assist with understanding all the costs that might be incurred throughout the school year the schedule is divided into three sections below.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been kept below the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

School Voluntary Contributions for Kindergarten to Year 6 students are:

- \$50 for one child
- \$100 for two children
- \$130 for a family of three or more children

While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be enhanced if each family makes a contribution. The contribution level sought represents approximately \$1.25 per student, for each week of the school year. The money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the literacy, numeracy, technology, LOTE and physical education areas.

Payments can be made by Cash, EFTPOS or Direct Deposit. To pay via Direct Deposit our banking details are BSB: 066 159 Acct: 0090 1860. Payments can be made in full or as part payments throughout the year. Payment can also be selected at the time of placing your student requirements.

PERSONAL USE ITEMS

These items (as per list) are approved by the School Board as being required by students for personal use in the education programs provided by the school. Please refer to the Requirements List for each year level. You are welcome to source student requirements through other providers.

Students' Requirement Lists will be available through Champion Education (Aust) Pty Ltd and will be distributed separately. The school negotiates competitive prices for all materials on the list and receives no commission from the supplier.

Uniforms are required for all students from Kindergarten to Year 6. The uniform shirt will need to be purchased through Tudor Uniform (on line or at the Uniform shop at Safety Bay SHS) but the other navy items can be sourced through any provider. Information on how to purchase through Tudor Uniform is available on our website. The uniform shop at Safety Bay SHS will be open 8.30 - 4.00pm Friday 31 January and Monday 3 February 2025. Once school commences the uniform shop at SBSH is open Wednesday and Friday 7.30am - 9.30am.
